2. Training Programmes for Cabin and Flight Crew

Managing Disruptive Passengers

Duration: from 8 hours

Objective: To equip crews with techniques to identify and manage disruptive passengers.

Content:

- Visual identification of potentially disruptive individuals
- Verbal de-escalation techniques
- Physical restraint in confined spaces
- Use of flexible restraint devices
- Techniques for coordinating crew and pilot

Target audience: Cabin crew, pilots, airline staff

In-flight Self-defence

Duration: from 16 hours

Objective: To provide self-defence skills adapted to aircraft environments.

Content:

- Risk levels and protocols for each threat level
- Soft control techniques in confined spaces
- Protocol for managing violent individuals
- Advanced restraint techniques and tactical pressure points

Target audience: Cabin crew seeking enhanced defensive capabilities

Hijack Protocols

Duration: from 8 hours

Objective: To train personnel in responding to hijacking or hostage-taking scenarios.

Content:

- Psychology of hijackers: profiles and motivations
- Basic methods of negotiation and verbal deescalation
- Coordination techniques between crew and pilots
- Use of improvised weapons
- Self-defence against edged and firearms

Target audience: Cabin crew, pilots, airline security personnel operating in high-risk areas

Personal Protection during Layovers

Duration: from 8 hours

Objective: To improve crew safety during layovers, especially in high-risk destinations.

Content:

- Security protocols in hotels and airports
- Personal defence against theft or kidnapping
- Use of improvised weapons
- Safe route planning techniques
- Response to civil unrest situations
- Organisation of security measures for small groups

Target audience: International crew, high-risk route operators

Vehicle Survival

Duration: from 8 hours

Objective: To train personnel in vehicle-based defence and survival strategies.

Content:

- Safe entry and exit of vehicles
- Self-defence in front and rear seats
- Techniques for escaping the boot
- Avoiding kidnappings when outside the vehicle
- Using the vehicle as a shield in aggressive or terrorist scenarios

Target audience: Crew operating in high-risk destinations

Training Programs for Airport Security Personnel

Managing Disruptive Passengers

Training for ground staff in the effective management of disruptive individuals, including visual identification, verbal deescalation techniques, control and reduction methods, and the use of flexible restraint devices.

Basic Airport Security (AVSEC)

Fundamental knowledge in airport security, including international regulations, identification of disruptive passengers, access control and credential verification, and protocols for bomb threats and suspicious packages.



Ground-based Self-defence

Provides security personnel with professional self-defence skills against grabs, strangulations and assaults, ground survival, defence against knives and firearms, and the use of control equipment and restraint devices.

Executive Aviation & VIP Security

Preparing agents for the protection of VIP passengers, including security protocols in private airport facilities, handling threats on private and charter flights, and escort and protection techniques.

Explosives and Hazardous Materials Detection

Duration: from 12 hours

Objective: To train personnel in the detection and management of hazardous substances.

Content:

- Types of explosives and hazardous chemicals
- Advanced use of X-ray scanners and explosive trace detectors
- Identification of disruptive behaviour
- Manual inspection and applied technology
- Protocols for suspicious baggage: isolation and communication
- Simulation exercises and detection training

Target audience: Baggage control, security teams, explosives detection units

Protection of Critical Airport Infrastructure

Duration: from 12 hours

Objective: To safeguard critical airport facilities against attacks or sabotage.

Content:

- Identification of security gaps and vulnerabilities
- Access control protocols for runways, hangars, VIP terminals
- Cybersecurity for airport computer systems
- Security in the transport of cargo and baggage
- Response protocols for terrorist threats in terminals
- Coordination with counter-terrorism and emergency services

Target audience: Airport security teams, infrastructure managers, law enforcement

Methodology and Compliance

All courses combine theoretical instruction with practical simulation, ensuring a high level of engagement and operational readiness.

Training programmes are developed and updated according to international security regulations and can be tailored to the specific needs of airlines, airport authorities, and security contractors.
